BACKGROUND

The Connaught School rebuild project was approved by the Ministry of Education in April, 2014. Once approved, RPS selected an architect of record to design the new school and established a school site-based planning committee, which included parents, teachers, RPS administrative personnel and Ministry representatives. The committee was established early in September and the first public consultation meeting was held on October 1, 2014.

CURRENT STATUS

Following the community meeting on October 1, 2014, at École Connaught Community School, the school's architects, the planning committee and School Division staff developed a school design. The design achieves the Division's seven guiding principles and addresses parent and community feedback that was received though the public meetings, as well as through the recent online ThoughtExchange process. This information was presented at a community meeting on December 18, 2014, held at the Cathedral Neighbourhood Centre.

Information from that session and a brief presentation will be provided to the Board to update the status of the project.
