2009-10 Budget Submission Information relative to the Division's original 2009-10 budget submission had been distributed. Ms. Debra Burnett, Deputy Director, Division Services, provided additional information, outlining the Ministry's direction that revenues and expenditures be increased by \$326,220 and restated in order to balance to
