

THE NEW COVID-19 VACCINE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE AND YOU

AP 140, COVID-19 Vaccination applies to everyone who works, volunteers or regularly enters our schools and facilities.

Full vaccination or recent proof of a negative test are required.

Masks are required in all buildings.

THIS APPLIES TO:

- ✓ All permanent, temporary, substitute and casual employees
- ✓ The Regina Board of Education Trustees
- ✓ Contracted school bus and light vehicle drivers
- ✓ Interning post-secondary students and those getting work experience or on apprenticeships
- ✓ Parents, caregivers, volunteers, presenters and members of the public who attend school-based activities (School Community Council meetings, lunch programs, field trips, coaching, tutors, in-person meetings/three-way conferences)
- ✓ Non-student spectators at school-hosted events
- ✓ Contractors working in and entering division schools and facilities
- ✓ Individuals associated with third-party programs delivered in schools (childcare, school-aged care, pre-school, student support programs)
- ✓ Individuals providing professional services (Social Services, School Resource Officers, SHA, Wascana Rehab, Ranch Ehrlo)
- ✓ Community members renting school facilities and participating in after-hours rentals

THIS DOES NOT APPLY TO:

- ✗ Students participating in curricular and extracurricular activities
- ✗ Parents/caregivers dropping off/picking up students or bringing in forgotten items, such as lunch (families are encouraged to minimize the time they spend in schools, unless they have a function to attend)
- ✗ Delivery personnel (Canada Post, couriers, etc.)
- ✗ Emergency personnel responding to a critical event (Fire, Police, SaskPower, SaskEnergy, City of Regina)
